

A HUNDRED FAMILIES IN FAYETTE

"A hundred families in Fayette" was a project of Mrs. Hill P. Redwine (Lucy Reagan) taking more than 15 years in the 1950's and 1960's. While they do not include every family, it was the ones she could assemble most readily. The file is in the "Margaret Mitchell Library", a copy is in the files of the Historical Society and it was micro-filmed for the state archives. There are errors which could not be avoided and it is hoped that interested parties will make such corrections as necessary. The names of some families have disappeared in Fayette and the only descendants are those coming from their daughters, while other families have carried on the name through their sons still in Fayette County.
