Water and electricity are now available on the property.



Ground Penetrating Radar

Ground Penetrating Radar Systems identified the location of unmarked graves. While most of the graves are outside of the cemetery fence, some are located inside.



Landscaping and Cemetery Clean Up

The landscaping project includes a memorial garden, providing a place for reflection. Whiteflowering, heirloom plants sourced from local families will be planted in the garden. Trees limbs were trimmed to prevent damage to the church and graves. Cemetery maintenance and the cleaning of graves is ongoing.

Historic Church Restoration

Volunteers have made significant progress in the removal of non-historic additions inside the church revealing the church's original window size, original door locations, and the tongue and groove walls.
